This award is one of the highest accolades a business can achieve, so tell us why your business is an outstanding all-round success!

Best community support

This category is open to any hairdressing, barbering, beauty or male grooming business or group of businesses.

Tell us how you've supported your community and made a real difference to the lives of others through activities in the local community or supporting a charity.

Make sure your statement covers the following points and ensure you provide recent evidence (eg press or PR coverage, letters from charities or community groups, fundraising pages) to support your statement.

Max 1500 words to cover all points.

- Description of the charity or community activity you're involved with
- Who was involved and what they did
- Why the charity or community activity matters to you
- What difference your support has made to the charity or your community

Best apprentice

This category is open to employers to nominate employees who are apprentices on a hairdressing, barbering or beauty apprenticeship programme or who have completed their programme within the last 6 months.

You may enter more than one apprentice for this category, but you need to complete a separate entry form for each one.

Make sure your statement covers the following points and ensure you provide recent evidence (eg certificates or awards, training and development plan) to support your statement.

Max 1500 words to cover all points.

- What your apprentice is studying and how long they've been studying for

- Their attendance and commitment
- Any additional responsibilities they have taken on or exceptional achievements or obstacles they have overcome
- Plans for their future progression

Best front of house

This category is open to any hairdressing, barbering, beauty or male grooming business with one or more receptionists or a 'meet and greet' person or a front of house team.

So often the unsung heroes, tell us how your front of house team members have gone the extra mile and made a real difference to your business.

WHY DO YOU THINK YOUR BUSINESS SHOULD WIN THIS AWARD?

Make sure your statement covers the following points and ensure you provide recent evidence (eg rebooking rate, client feedback) to support your statement.

Max 1500 words to cover all points.

- Who is in your front of house team
- What they do and how they make a difference to the salon/barbershop
- What is your 'meet and greet' process and how it adds to the client experience
- How they encourage retail sales or repeat bookings
- How they work with other team members and contribute to the team as a whole
- Special ideas they have come up with or how they've gone the extra mile

Please also provide a brief overview of your business including how many people work in it (whether employees or chair/room renters).

Best environmentally friendly business

This award is open to any hairdressing, barbering, beauty or male grooming business or group of businesses which has focussed on being environmentally friendly and sustainable.

Tell us how being 'green' has been good for your business as well as for the environment.

WHY DO YOU THINK YOUR BUSINESS SHOULD WIN THIS AWARD?

Make sure your statement covers the following points and ensure you provide recent evidence (eg client feedback, cost savings) to support your statement.

Max 1500 words to cover all points.

- How your salon or barbershop is environmentally friendly
- How that has helped you develop your business
- Savings such as reducing energy or water consumption
- Imaginative ways of raising 'green' awareness with your clients and your team

Please also provide a brief overview of your business including how many people work in it (whether employees or chair/room renters).

Max 200 words.





Rules

- 1. Entries must be made by completing the entry form. Entries and photos will only be accepted as electronic files, sent via WeTransfer, Dropbox or similar, or put onto a memory stick and posted to:
 - NHF Business Awards, National Hairdressers Federation, One Abbey Court, Fraser Road, Priory Business Park, Bedford MK44 3WH
- 2. Make sure you provide the evidence required for each category.
- 3. If you want to include photos, make sure they show the outside of the business, a clear view of the interior and a group shot of the salon team. Do not submit more than THREE photos. At this stage photos can be low resolution, but you must have high resolution versions (JPEGs or TIFFs 300dpi minimum) available if you are selected as a finalist. Photos must also be submitted electronically, using the same method as all other entry materials.
- 4. Any photos submitted may be published in salonfocus magazine, other media (eg trade press) and on the NHF website. You are responsible for ensuring that anyone shown in the photos consents to their image being used in this way.
- 5. Entry into the awards is deemed to be approval of and consent for photos to be used as set out in this entry rule.
- 6. Entry is open only to salons within the UK.
- 7. Members of the NHF's National Executive Council (Board) are not eligible to enter the awards or to be judges.
- 8. We will acknowledge receipt of all entries by email or phone, so if you don't receive an acknowledgement we haven't received your entry.
- If you are a finalist, you must attend the Awards dinner. Tickets, travel and accommodation will be at your own expense.

Judging

- 10. You must stick to the word count allowed for each category. Judges will disregard any text which is longer than the rules allow.
- 11. All information you provide is strictly confidential and will be seen only by NHF staff and judges, who will have signed a confidentiality agreement.
- 12. There will be up to 3 judges per category, drawn from a pool of NHF business trainers, coaches, subject experts and sponsors.
- 13. Judges will consider all entries and allocate scores using the judging criteria for each category.
- 14. There will be up to five finalists in each category, those who achieve the highest scores.

- 15. Scores will be independently reviewed before arriving at the overall results.
- 16. There will be a mystery shop for the finalists of the following categories:
 - Best independent hair or beauty salon
 - Best independent barbershop or male grooming business
 - Best group of businesses (2 salons, a flagship location nominated by the entrant and one other selected at random by the NHF)
 - Best new business
 - Best client experience
 - Best front of house
- 17. Finalists in all of the above categories will be given a free copy of the mystery shopping report after the Awards event.
- 18. Winners of all categories will receive a trophy, a press pack and a certificate.
- 19. The judges' decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Finalists

- 20. Finalists will be announced on Monday 4
 September 2017. A list of finalists will be
 published in *salonfocus* magazine, on the NHF
 website and promoted online.
- 21. If you are a finalist, you will be asked to provide a copy of the following:
 - Insurance policy
 - Health & safety policy
 - Customer complaints policy

The NHF has a health and safety toolkit which includes a template health and safety policy, and a guide on handling complaints which includes a template complaints policy if you need any help.

- 22. Finalists must attend the Awards dinner, to be held at the VOX Conference Centre, part of the Resorts World complex at the NEC, Birmingham on the evening of **Sunday 19 November 2017**. No travel or accommodation expenses will be paid. Tickets cost £95 per person from a member salon (£150 for non-member salons). You can't be a winner unless you're at the dinner!
- 23. As a finalist or a winner, you agree to take part in all publicity organised by the NHF to celebrate your success and to promote the awards for future years.
