

## Compliance checklist

### SALONS AND BARBERSHOPS IN ENGLAND: KEEP YOUR TEAM AND CLIENTS SAFE

Is your business COVID-compliant? If not, your business could be shut down again and you may face fines or even prison.



Regularly review your **risk assessment** in consultation with staff.



Operate an **appointment-only** system.



**Avoid** face-to-face working



Type II face masks and face visors **must be worn** by staff providing services and treatments.



Face coverings **must be worn** by clients except those who are exempt such as under-11s and those with medical conditions. Clients' face coverings should **not be removed** unless essential for a particular treatment.



When not carrying out a service or treatment, maintain **social distancing** of two metres (or one metre if not possible & further risk prevention is in place such as visors or screens).



Staff to **wash hands regularly** throughout the day and always between clients.



Regular **cleaning and sanitising** must be carried out throughout the day and always between appointments.



Keep client contact details for 21 days to support the **'Test and Trace'** service.
