Business



Over half of hair and beauty businesses have an annual turnover of less than £99k.



There are over **46,000** hair and beauty businesses in the UK, a rise of over **1,300** (3%).



The hair and beauty industry generated **£5.5bn** in turnover in 2019-20.



Almost three-quarters of hair and beauty businesses employ fewer than five people and 94% employ fewer than ten people.



Despite the **pandemic**, the number of hairdressing, barbering and beauty businesses **continued to grow** year on year, albeit at a slower rate than in previous years.

People



The hairdressing and beauty workforce declined by around **7,000** (2.5%).



63% of people working in the hair and beauty sector are self-employed.



Almost half the workforce are aged 16-34.



Over **86%** of the workforce are **female**.



Around 6,600 people started hairdressing and barbering apprenticeships in England in 2020/21 compared to around 7,000 in 2019/20. This is a drop of 9% compared to the previous year.
